I am pleased to inform you that your application for registration with this Council has been accepted and that you have been enrolled as a Probationer Builder on the National Register of House-Builders and Developers.

Please quote your membership registration number in all correspondence.

The period of probation will be kept under review by our Regional Director and you will be advanced to the Full Register when you have completed a number of houses to the satisfaction of the Council. During the probationary period you may inform prospective purchasers that the Council's ten-year warranty will be available for all houses which earn the Council's Standard Notice of Insurance Cover, but you are not permitted to display NHBC publicity material.

The attached leaflet explains the principal obligations as a member of the Probationer Register. In particular you should:

1. DESIGN AND BUILD TO COMPLY WITH THE NHBC SPECIFICATIONS. The full-size handbook will be sent to you shortly.
2. APPLY FOR THE INSPECTION OF ALL NEW DWELLINGS AT LEAST 21 DAYS BEFORE CONSTRUCTION IS BEGUN. Failure to do this may result in increased inspection and insurance fees. Application forms are enclosed and should be returned together with your cheque to cover the appropriate fees. If you are building for a registered developer it is the developer's responsibility to apply for dwelling registration and to pay the appropriate fees.
3. REGISTER ANY DWELLINGS WHICH HAVE BEEN UNDER INSPECTION DURING THE NEGOTIATIONS FOR YOUR MEMBERSHIP BY SUBMITTING THE ENCLOSED APPLICATION FORM TOGETHER WITH YOUR CHEQUE FOR THE FEES.
